## SPRINGFIELD SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION RULES AND POLICIES

(Amended July 18, 2023)

The following rules and policies are designed primarily to speed up play.

- 1. Play ready golf
- 2. Putts are good inside the normal putter length (i.e., 36 inches).
- 3. Maximum of three puts per hole. After the second putt, pick up, add another stroke, and move on.
- 4. Triple bogey is the maximum score per hole. Once you reach triple bogey pick up and move on.
- 5. Out of bounds should be played as a lateral hazard. With a one stroke penalty, place the ball within two club lengths of the line of flight where the ball crossed out of bounds.
- 6. Balls may be played UP.
- Balls should be played out of sand traps as normal. Any exceptions to this rule (e.g., traps are considered unplayable) will be announced before the round begins.
- 8. Balls may be moved from lateral hazards (not sand traps) with a one stroke penalty. Drop the ball within two club lengths from the hazard.
- Balls may be moved one club length with no penalty if the ball is considered unplayable – it is on a cart path, on a sprinkler head, etc.
- 10. There is a 3-minute limit on the search for any lost ball
- 11. If all players in a group agree that a player's ball was in play and not in a hazard or out of bounds, in the event that after the 3 minute search if the ball is not found, the player may drop a ball and **proceed with no penalty**.
